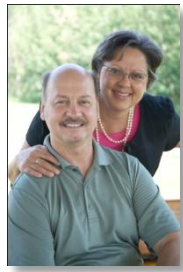


Gary and Gwen Bistritan

- **To oversee the worship services at both of the island's churches as well as local Bible study groups.**
- **To oversee various ministries, communications, and outreach events in the Micronesia area.**

Commissioned as missionaries to Guam in June 1985, the Bistritans began pastoring the church in Guam in January 1986; in 1993 their assignment was expanded to include church planting in Micronesia.

For the past eight years, they have also been using small home groups and one-on-one discipleship to help the church and young Christians grow to maturity. Because personal relationships are more important than events in this culture, this method is proving fruitful.

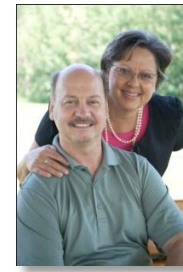
