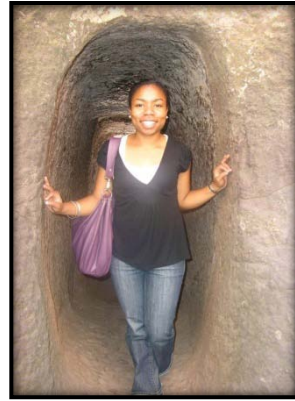


Nelecia Murrell

- **To build evangelistic relationships by making contacts for the churches through these teaching opportunities.**

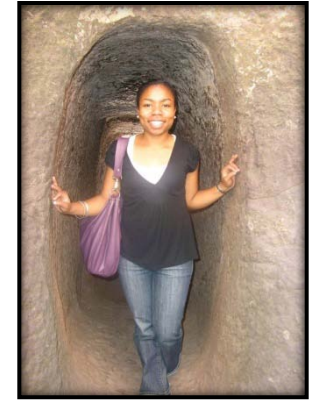
